Re: Northbound B63 Reroute in Downtown Brooklyn

Dear Mr. ~~Hammerman~~^{Craig}:

This is to inform you of NYC Transit's service revision to the northbound B63 bus route in Downtown Brooklyn, which will result in B63 buses traveling from the intersection of 5th Avenue and Flatbush Avenue to Atlantic Avenue and Flatbush Avenue via Flatbush Avenue, rather than 5th Avenue (see attached map). This reroute will take effect upon the closure and de-mapping of 5th Avenue between Flatbush Avenue and Atlantic Avenue in the near future.

As you are aware, a short segment of 5th Avenue, from Flatbush Avenue to Atlantic Avenue, will be de-mapped as a result of the construction of the Atlantic Yards Arena. Currently, northbound traffic is prohibited from making a left-hand turn from northbound Flatbush Avenue to westbound Atlantic Avenue. MTA NYC Transit and the NYC Department of Transportation have agreed that traffic regulations will be changed at this location to "No Left Turn Except Buses", similar to the current situation for the eastbound B45, which travels southbound on Flatbush Avenue and turns left onto eastbound Atlantic Avenue.

The date of implementation of this reroute is expected to be May 27, 2007.
