During the month of February, the Division of Bridges (NYDOT) began repairs to the structural grating of the deck of the Union Street Bridge. While underway, the engineers identified additional work that will be required to fully complete the deck upgrade. The expansion of the scope of the project will require work on four additional Saturdays in April as listed below. NYCDOT thanks you for your patience and understanding and apologizes for any inconvenience.

**Bridge closed from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
on the following Saturdays:
*March 6, 13, 20, 27 and April 3, 10, 17 and 24***

Vehicular and pedestrian traffic may use the adjacent Carroll Street or Third Street Bridges to cross the Gowanus Canal. To notify the public of the closure, Variable Message Sign Boards will be placed on the west side of the bridge seven days in advance of the work. Future updates will be provided as work progresses.
