Dear Parents and Neighbors of the John Jay Educational Campus:

The New York City School Construction Authority (SCA) wishes to advise you that a construction project will begin at the school.

The work includes a Boiler Upgrade.

The work will begin shortly and the expected completion date is in December, 2011.

After Labor Day, and with a Department of Transportation permit, there will a sidewalk closure by the school on 4<sup>th</sup> St. The closure will last until the end of the project.

The work requires asbestos abatement. This material does not easily create airborne fibers or pose potential fiber exposure to surrounding occupants. The workers who are in actual contact with the material will be wearing protective suits and respirators and there will be containment of these materials.

The removal work is being performed by a licensed abatement contractor and managed by an environmental consulting firm. Representatives of the environmental consulting firm are on site for the duration of the abatement to ensure the contractor adheres to all proper regulations.

The consultant also monitors the air in the immediate area to ensure that the removal is taking place properly. Test results are made available at the school to all interested parties.

In order not to interrupt the learning environment, work will take place after school hours and on weekends and school holidays.

Although this renovation will inevitably cause noise, the SCA will strive to minimize the disruptions to you and your neighbors

We apologize for any inconvenience and will attempt to complete the work as quickly as possible.
